



## Refrigerator/Freezer Hazard Identification

A customized inventory should be taped to the exterior of **each** refrigerator or freezer.

### **Contact Information**

These contacts should have detailed knowledge of the materials being stored within the refrigerator/freezer and be able to assist ESSR in the case of a loss in power or other incident involving the piece of equipment. Phone number should be a number that can be reached day or night in case of an emergency.
