Application for State Discharge Permit 17DP2618, NPDES Permit MD0063801:

University of Maryland College Park, Department of Environmental Safety, Sustainability and Risk, 4716 Pontiac Street, Seneca Bldg., Suite 0103, College Park, MD 20742 submitted an application for renewal of a permit to discharge 550,000 gallons per day of noncontact cooling water, dehumidifier condensate, boiler blowdown, and steam condensate from the campus heating and cooling system, located at the University of Maryland, College Park, MD, to Paint Branch (Use I), Campus Creek (a Use I tributary of Paint Branch), and Guilford Run (a Use I tributary of Northeast Branch Anacostia River).
